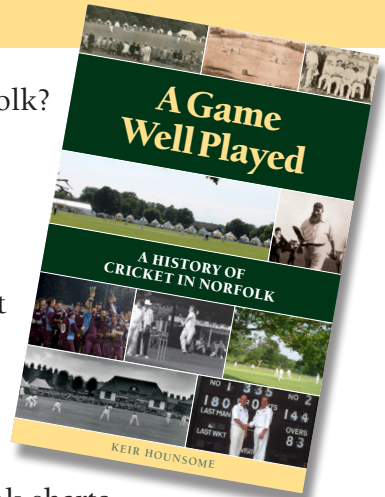


A Game Well Played
